
THE VILLAGE COUNCIL WISHES ALL RESIDENTS A VERY MERRY CHRISTMAS

CCTV UPDATE The Village Council has been progressing this project and are pleased to let residents know it is anticipated that

UKPowernetworks will be installing the first phase of the necessary electrical connections in January 2020. The project is a complex one with many agencies involved including the suppliers. This has involved liaising with them all to ensure that residents have CCTV at South green. This step forward makes it likely that the CCTV will be operational at South Green later in 2020. Residents have expressed their support of the project.

PATHS ON THE GREEN

The Village Council is investigating having the internal paths on the green refurbished. For health's sake the paths will be marked with distance e.g. how many metres/yards covered by walkers/joggers. The refurbishment will also mean the disabled and elderly can use the paths within the green with greater ease. The project is at an early stage and is at the request of residents.

NEW BENCH ON THE GREEN - Three groups of residents approached the Village Council about a new bench on the Green to commemorate their relatives. Previously other residents had asked for an extra bench on the Southend Road side of the green. A location was selected with the help of Basildon Borough Council. The Village Council approved the siting of the bench. The residents who wished to commemorative their relatives fully funded the bench which was installed by Basildon Borough Council.

REMEMBRANCE SUNDAY ST MARY MAGDALENE GREAT BURSTEAD

Village Councillors attended the solemn church service on 10th November lead by Fr Graham Laut. A wreath was laid on behalf of the Village Council at the plaque to the fallen in the Church porch.

COXES FARM ROAD - We raised speeding concerns regarding with Essex County Council requesting a reduction to the 40mph speed limit. A speed survey was carried out between 21st/27th November 2018 with monitoring magnetic strips at either end of the road. We felt these sites would not fully reflect the high speeds vehicles regularly achieve. When the speed survey was taken it was set against a speed limit of 60mph at the north end of Coxes Farm Road. The Village Council pointed out that the speed limit there was in fact 40mph and were informed that it made little difference. All avenues have now been exhausted.
