TWO SPECIAL CONSTABLES FOR OUR VILLAGE

In January 2018 the Village Council unanimously resolved to take part in the Essex Police Special Constables scheme. A representative of Essex Police attended our January meeting and explained the benefits of the scheme. It was then decided to go ahead and request that Essex Police provide two Special Constables for our village.

The Village Council will fund the reasonable expenses of the two Special Constables who will be dedicated to patrolling and concentrating on concerns within the village. They would only be drawn away from the village if there were very serious incidents elsewhere. The Village Council will also fund the shift allowance for each Special Constable of £1000 per year. Special Constables will provide reassurance and a police presence.

Precept to Rise by 1.4 Pence a Week The precept, the local taxation residents pay for Village Council projects and activities, has not risen for over 8 years. As Basildon Borough Council stopped providing the Local Council Tax Support Grant, which made up part of the precept, it was resolved to raise the precept. Should the grant be reinstated next year the precept may be lowered. The rise to £12.15 per annum for a Band D property (which will be slightly higher or lower depending on band) equates to 1.4 pence a week - 72 pence per annum. The Village Council still has the lowest precept of all the Basildon Borough Local Councils and it is also one of the lowest precepts in Essex.



CCTV AT SOUTH GREEN CONSULTATION

The Village Council is assessing the installation of CCTV at South Green. The installation would comprise four cameras mounted on a pole near the bell bollards, at the exit of the shops car park, South Green. The cameras store high quality images 24/7. The CCTV would not be trained on residents' windows in the apartments over the shops or those of Southwood Court as it is possible to block the cameras from viewing or storing images from given areas. The cameras would have quite a wide scope; to the far side of the green, to the recycling point, onto the Southend Road, the shops car park and parade of shops.

We are in the process of taking part in the Special Constables scheme, initiated by Essex Police, and when Special Constables are appointed it will be possible to give them access to live images to aid their patrols.

CCTV will be a deterrent to issues which arise around the area. CCTV will provide extra safety for our residents which is strongly supported by the Village Council.
